

MICHELE LUNDEEN “The Queen of Steam”



Prepare for an unforgettable experience when versatile singer, songwriter Michele Lundeen hits the stage. A soulful, mesmerizing vocalist, Michele effortlessly blends classic and contemporary Blues, Memphis soul, jump swing, Texas boogie, roots rock, rhythm & blues, sultry jass, New Orleans funk and more into a satisfying musical stew.

While her energetic, infectious style is truly all her own, Michele Lundeen has been compared to artists such as Bonnie Raitt, Janis Joplin, Tina Turner, Etta James, Aretha Franklin and shades of Billie Holiday. Reaching into the audience with emotional vocals and body language, she's been dubbed "The Queen of Steam" for her electrifying vocal and stage presence. Michele commands attention with talent and warmth and enjoys including the audience in an entertaining, musical romp. Among notable events, she has headlined the 1st National Women In Blues Festival (Wilmington, NC) and the San Felipe Blues & Arts Fiesta (where she's been invited back 8x); has been like a Pied Piper at numerous Gator By The Bay Festivals (San Diego, CA); raised the temperature at the Colorado Belle Blues & Brews Fest (Laughlin, NV); had fans racing to her San Diego Blues Fest stage; packed Rollin' On The River (Reno, NV), rock 'n rolled 'em right in the prestigious Legendary Rhythm & Blues Cruise showroom (high seas) and let the good times roll for thousands during the 2012 and 2013 TGIF Jazz In The Park (Carlsbad) summer concert series!

Before relocating to San Diego in 1997, Michele entertained the northern Nevada-California area for several years where she still has a strong fan-base. She and her band have been the support act for dozens of national touring acts such as Elvin Bishop, John Lee Hooker, Debbie Davies, Kim Wilson, Coco Montoya, and more, have performed at top local venues and a variety of festivals as well as private/corporate functions. She's equally at home in outdoor, all-age festival settings as well as large or intimate club venues offering blues, soul and rock or her **Madame LeRoux alias** (New Orleans R&B show in costume!), or her rousing R&B **Etta James/Koko Taylor Tribute**.

Michele is a multiple San Diego Music Award “Best Blues” nominee. She also represented Blues Lovers United of San Diego (BLUSD) in the “International Blues Challenge” in Memphis, TN, after placing first in the BLUSD regional Blues Challenge. Her debut CD, *Song Inside Me* was Nominated San Diego Music Award “Best Blues Album” and also one of the “Best Self-Produced CD” Final Four in the Blues Foundation’s prestigious International Blues Challenge (IBC) category. The 12 track CD features nine of Michele’s self-penned originals, showcasing her passionate, dynamic, versatile vocals and entwining her old-school R&B and blues based roots (plus a love of Gospel) around each track. The CD receives airplay across the U.S., Canada and abroad and has garnered positive reviews and countless new fans. As a songwriter, Lundeen's lyrics are poignant, sometimes tongue 'n cheek with arrangements that are down-home yet catchy and danceable.
